Monthly Summary for January 2025

Issued February 3, 2025

For the month of January, rainfall totals averaged 1.23 inches throughout the state. According to the January 28th, US Drought Monitor Report, 26 percent of the state was in the abnormally dry to exceptional drought category, up 4 points from the previous year. Additionally, 5 percent of the state was in the moderate drought to exceptional drought category, down 2 points from the previous year. Statewide temperatures averaged in the 30's, with the lowest recording of -17 degrees at Beaver on Tuesday, January 21st and the highest recording of 75 degrees at Tipton on Friday, January 17th. Topsoil and subsoil moisture conditions were rated mostly adequate to short.

Small Grains: Winter wheat grazed reached 39 percent, down 16 points from the previous year. Rye grazed reached 22 percent, down 19 points from previous year. Oats grazed reached 10 percent, up 6 points from the previous year.

Pasture and Livestock: Pasture and range condition was rated at 73 percent fair to good. Livestock condition was rated at 85 percent good to fair.
