**Monthly Summary for January 2025** 

Issued February 3, 2025

For the month of January, rainfall totals averaged 1.23 inches throughout the state. According to the January 28<sup>th</sup>, US Drought Monitor Report, 26 percent of the state was in the abnormally dry to exceptional drought category, up 4 points from the previous year. Additionally, 5 percent of the state was in the moderate drought to exceptional drought category, down 2 points from the previous year. Statewide temperatures averaged in the 30's, with the lowest recording of -17 degrees at Beaver on Tuesday, January 21<sup>st</sup> and the highest recording of 75 degrees at Tipton on Friday, January 17<sup>th</sup>. Topsoil and subsoil moisture conditions were rated mostly adequate to short.

**Small Grains:** Winter wheat grazed reached 39 percent, down 16 points from the previous year. Rye grazed reached 22 percent, down 19 points from previous year. Oats grazed reached 10 percent, up 6 points from the previous year.

**Pasture and Livestock**: Pasture and range condition was rated at 73 percent fair to good. Livestock condition was rated at 85 percent good to fair.
