Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.13 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 2, down 7 percent from the week prior and down 6 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 2, was 4.26 million, up 9 percent from the previous week and up 26 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.1 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 2, down 2 percent from the week prior and down 5 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 2, was 14.4 million, up 5 percent from the previous week and down 2 percent from the previous year.
