This report contains the results from the March 2021 Hog and Pig Survey. Data provided by Oklahoma and Texas producers are the foundation of the estimates made for the Southern Plains region. We would like to thank all producers who responded to the survey. Results from the next quarterly survey will be made available June 24, 2021.

### **Oklahoma Highlights**

The March 1, 2021 Oklahoma hog and pig inventory, at 2.04 million head, was 9 percent lower than March 2020. The number of **breeding hogs** totaled 460 thousand head, up 10 thousand from last year. The March 1 **market hog** inventory was down 12 percent from a year ago at 1.58 million head, 77 percent of the total hog and pig inventory.


The December 2020-February 2021 Oklahoma **pig crop** totaled 2.12 million head, 1 percent below last year. Pigs per litter averaged 10.1, down 3 percent from the previous year. Sows farrowed during December 2020 through February 2021 totaled 210 thousand head, up 2 percent from last year.

### **Texas Highlights**

The March 1, 2021 Texas hog and pig inventory, at 1.06 million head, was 5 percent lower than March 2020. The number of **breeding hogs** totaled 160 thousand head, up 5 thousand from last year. The March 1 **market hog** inventory was down 6 percent from a year ago at 900 thousand head, 85 percent of the total hog and pig inventory.

The December 2020-February 2021 Texas **pig crop** totaled 717 thousand head, 2 percent above last year. Pigs per litter averaged 10.1, down 2 percent from the previous year. Sows farrowed during December 2020 through February 2021 totaled 71.0 thousand head, up 4 percent from last year.





### **U.S. Highlights**

The U.S. inventory of all hogs and pigs on March 1, 2021, is estimated at 74.8 million head, down 2 percent from a year ago and down 3 percent from December 1, 2020. The **breeding hog inventory**, at 6.21 million head, was down 3 percent from last year and down 1 percent from the previous quarter. **Market hog** inventory, at 68.6 million head, was down 2 percent from last year and down 3 percent from last quarter.

The U.S. **pig crop** for December 2020-February 2021, at 33.3 million, was down 1 percent from 2020. U.S. producers intend to have 3.07 million sows farrow during the March 2021-May 2021 period, down 3 percent from the actual farrowings during the same period last year. Intended farrowings for June 2021-August 2021, at 3.12 million sows, are down 4 percent from the same quarter the year prior.
