Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.57 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 11, up 1 percent from the week prior but down 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 11, was 4.66 million, up 17 percent from the previous week but down 5 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.1 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 11, down slightly from the week prior and down 5 percent from the previous vear.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 11, was 14.3 million, down 1 percent from the previous week and down 4 percent from the previous year.
