**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 5.77 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 14, up 11 percent from the week prior but down 10 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 14, was 4.78 million, up 10 percent from the previous week and up 5 percent from the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 19.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 14, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 4 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 14, was 15.3 million, up slightly from the previous week and up 5 percent from the previous year.
