**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 6.02 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 22, up 4 percent from the week prior but down 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 22, was 4.01 million, up 1 percent from the previous week and up 3 percent from the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 19.5 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 22, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 7 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 22, was 15.3 million, down slightly from the previous week but up 1 percent from the previous year.
