**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 5.83 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 14, down 4 percent from the week prior and down 13 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of September 14, was 3.73 million, down 7 percent from the previous week and down 18 percent from the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 17.7 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 14, down 7 percent from the week prior and down 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of September 14, was 15.5 million, down 1 percent from the previous week but up 4 percent from the previous year.
