**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 6.06 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 29, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 29, was 2.84 million, down 29 percent from the previous week and down 34 percent from the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 19.6 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 29, up slightly from the week prior and up 7 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 29, was 14.4 million, down 6 percent from the previous week but up 2 percent from the previous year.
