**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 5.77 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 4, down 5 percent from the week prior and down 9 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 4, was 3.53 million, up 24 percent from the previous week but down 8 percent from the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 19.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 4, down 2 percent from the week prior and up 4 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 4, was 14.7 million, up 2 percent from the previous week but up slightly from the previous year.
