Oklahoma hatcheries set 5.80 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 15, down 2 percent from the week prior but up 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 15, was 3.39 million, down 8 percent from the previous week and down 10 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 19.4 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 15, down slightly from the week prior but up slightly from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 15, was 15.2 million, up 3 percent from the previous week and up 2 percent from the previous year.
