All Wheat Stocks Stored in Northwest Region Up 20 Percent from September 1, 2023

All wheat stored in all positions on September 1, 2024 totaled 80.2 million bushels in Idaho, up from 65.0 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 27 percent, while on-farm stocks were up 18 percent compared to the previous year. In Oregon, wheat stored in all positions totaled 49.0 million bushels, up from 38.3 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 26 percent, while on-farm stocks were up 35 percent compared to the previous year. In Washington, wheat stored in all positions totaled 159 million bushels, up from 137 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 16 percent, while on-farm stocks were up 19 percent compared to the previous year. Nationally, wheat stored in all positions totaled 1.99 billion bushels, up from 1.77 billion bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 13 percent, while on-farm stocks were up 11 percent compared to the previous year.

Barley stocks in all positions on September 1, 2024 totaled 42.6 million bushels in Idaho, down from 49.0 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 10 percent, while on-farm stocks were down 24 percent compared to the previous year. In Oregon, barley stored in all positions totaled 1.07 million bushels, up from 738,000 bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 29 percent, while on-farm stocks were up 67 percent compared to the previous year. In Washington, barley stored in all positions totaled 5.04 million bushels, down from 6.02 million a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 3 percent, while on-farm stocks were down 46 percent compared to the previous year. Nationally, barley stored in all positions totaled 154 million bushels, down from a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 15 percent, while on-farm stocks were down 27 percent compared to the previous year.


Oats stored in off-farm locations on September 1, 2024 totaled 211,000 bushels in Idaho, down from 225,000 bushels a year ago. In Oregon, off-farm stocks were 258,000 bushels, down 12 percent from the previous year. In Washington, off-farm stocks were 82,000 bushels, up 14 percent from the previous year. Nationally, oats stored in all positions totaled 65.2 million bushels, down from 75.3 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were 26.6 million, down 33 percent from the previous year, while on-farm stocks were 38.6 million, up 9 percent compared to the previous year.
