Season average prices received by Pennsylvania farmers for products they sold in 1998 were lower. Hog prices drop to a 26-year low after posting a noticeable increase in 1997, dropped to the lowest level since 1972. While corn, oats, barley, winter wheat, rye, soybeans, potatoes, hay, tobacco, apples, sheep, lamb, chickens, turleys, eggs and wool also declined; prices improved for cows, calves, and broilers. Prices received by farmers for milk cows were at an all time high in 1998.

Preliminary cash receipts from marketings in 1998 was \$4.20 billion. Total cash income from crops was estimated

at \$1.26 billion, down 5 percent from 1997.

Cash income received from livestock and livestock products, at \$2.91 billion, was up 4 percent from last year. Net farm income in 1998 was \$684.3 million, up 24 percent from the previous year.

The USDA's Economic Research Service no longer computes gross farm income. The value-added format presented on Page 107 is now used to present the agricultural sector income account. Underlying accounting and concepts remain the same under the new format.
