The Commonwealth's five major fruit crops are comprised of apples, peaches, pears, tart cherries and grapes. These crops produced a total utilized weight of 639 million pounds, down 2 percent from 2011.

Apples - The 2012 commercial apple crop, utilized production, in Pennsylvania totaled 475 million pounds, up 8 percent from utilized production in 2011. The crop was valued at 133.6 million dollars, up 68 percent from the 2011 value. Pennsylvania ranked 3rd nationally in utilized apple production.

Grapes - Pennsylvania's 2012 grape crop, utilized production, was 59,000 tons, down 32 percent from 2011. The total value of utilized production was 20.6 million dollars. The Commonwealth's utilized grape production ranked 4th nationally.

Pears - The utilized production of pears in Pennsylvania totaled 990 tons, down 53 percent from 2011. The utilized crop was valued at 786 thousand dollars. The Commonwealth ranked 5th nationally in utilized pear production.

Peaches - Utilized peach production in Pennsylvania totaled 20,350 tons in 2012, up 18 percent from 2011. The season-average price of \$1060 per ton was down \$300 from 2011. The total value of utilized production was 21.7 million dollars. Nationally, Pennsylvania ranked 5th in utilized peach production.

Tart Cherries - Utilized tart cherry production in Pennsylvania totaled 3.2 million pounds, up 3 percent from last year's crop. The season average price was 1.110 dollars per pound, compared with 0.371 dollars per pound in 2011. The total value of utilized production was 3.56 million dollars. Nationally, Pennsylvania ranked 4th in utilized production of tart cherries.
