Pennsylvania hog inventory up 4 percent from 2023

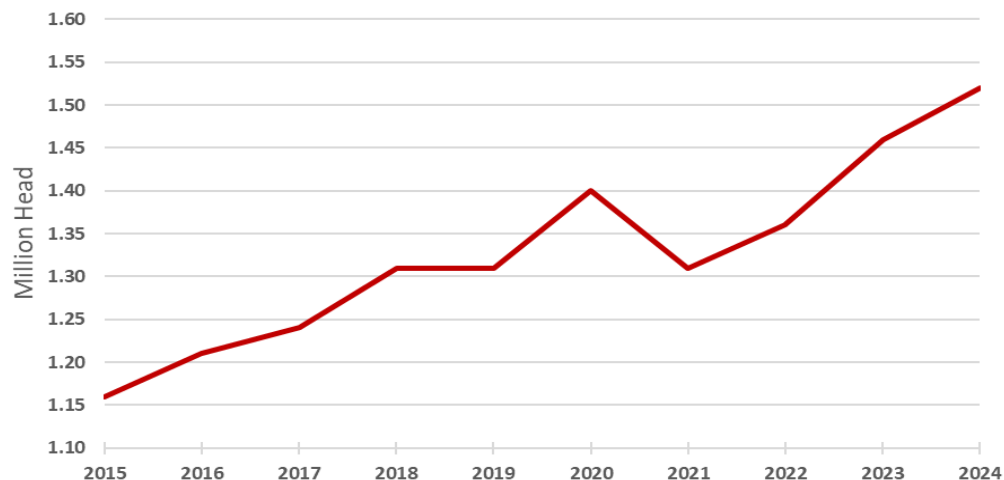
Pennsylvania inventory of all hogs and pigs on December 1, 2024, was 1.52 million head. This was up 4 percent from December 1, 2023, and up 3 percent from September 1, 2024, according to USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service, *Quarterly Hogs and Pigs* report.

Breeding inventory at 160 thousand head was unchanged from last year, and up 3 percent from the previous quarter.

Market hog inventory at 1.36 million head was up 5 percent from last year, and up 3 percent from last quarter.

The Sept-Nov. 2024 pig crop at 552 thousand head was down 5 percent from 2023. Sows farrowing during this period totaled 48 thousand head, down 2 percent from 2023. The average pigs saved per litter was 11.50 for the Sept-Nov period, down 3 percent from last year.
