The estimates in this report are based primarily on the December 2024 Agricultural Survey which was conducted during the first two weeks of December. The estimates provided in this report are intended to reflect grower plantings for the 2025 crop year. These estimates will not be revised; instead, new estimates will be made throughout the growing season as additional survey data and administrative data are received. Thanks to all the farm operators who responded to this survey and made these estimates possible.

U.S. winter wheat seeded area for 2025 is expected to total 34.1 million acres, up 2 percent from 2024. Alabama seedings are estimated at 150,000 acres, up 36 percent from the previous year. Georgia seedings are estimated at 190,000 acres, up 31 percent from 2024. South Carolina seedings are estimated at 125,000 acres, up 56 percent from the previous year.
