US Cattle Inventory Down 1 Percent

Inventory of all cattle and calves in the United States, as of January 1, 2025, totaled 86.7 million head, down 1 percent from the 87.2 million head on January 1, 2024. All cows and heifers that have calved, at 37.2 million head, were slightly below the 37.4 million head on January 1, 2024. Beef cows, at 27.9 million head, were down 1 percent from a year ago. Milk cows, at 9.35 million head, were up slightly from the previous year. Alabama all cattle and calves totaled 1.18 million head, up 1 percent from January 1, 2024. Florida all cattle and calves inventory was unchanged from the previous year at 1.56 million head. All cattle and calves in Georgia totaled 990,000 head, down 2 percent from 2024. South Carolina all cattle and calves inventory, at 295,000 head, was up 2 percent from the previous year.




