

## REPORTS AND DATA FROM THE USDA'S NATIONAL AGRICULTURAL STATISTICS SERVICE (NASS)

### INTERNET

Reports and data from USDA's NASS as well as the South Dakota Field Office (SDFO) are available on the Internet. Information is also available on the websites of the South Dakota Department of Agriculture (SDDA) and South Dakota State University (SDSU).

### Internet Estimates Database (Quick Stats):

Historical County, State, and U.S. information is available on the Internet. The database uses queries based on commodity, year, State, and other criteria to customize an output file compatible for updating databases and spreadsheets. The database can be accessed from the NASS Homepage shown above. Enter your search criteria by clicking on the more arrow to the right of **Quick Stats**. Searches can be done on **U.S. and State Data**, **State and County Data**, or data from the **Census of Agriculture**.

### EMAIL SUBSCRIPTIONS

#### NASS Reports:

Subscriptions to NASS reports are offered free through our email service. From the right hand side of the NASS Homepage, under "Follow NASS", select **National** under the heading **Receive reports by Email**. To set up a new account select **Register** at the bottom of the page. Fill in and submit the information and a confirmation will be sent to your email address. To select the reports you would like to receive follow the instructions in the email. The National report(s) you selected will be delivered as soon as they are published.

#### SDFO Reports:

State specific reports are also available free via email. Again, go to the NASS Homepage as above and select **State** under the heading **Receive reports by Email**. Choose the State report you would like to receive, enter your name and email address and then click on **Submit**.

### NASS SUBJECT SPECIALISTS

NASS maintains a listing of subject and commodity specialists for the various program areas. From the right side of the NASS Homepage, click on **Ask a Specialist**, choose the commodity in question, and the specialist's name, email address and phone will appear.

### PRINTED REPORTS

NASS operates an information center, staffed 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. eastern time Monday-Friday, to assist you with accessing reports and data via the Internet, or obtaining printed copies. Please call **1-800-727-9540**.

#### Reports Calendar:

A calendar of all release dates is available on the NASS Homepage. Click on the **Publications** tab at the top of the page. Choose the month in question or choose a commodity from the **Most Requested Reports**.

#### Printed Report Subscriptions:

Printed copies of NASS reports are available for a fee to subscribers. To subscribe for national reports, call toll-free **1-800-999-6779** and ask for a list of reports and prices.

#### **Crop and Livestock Reporter:**

A monthly comprehensive farm newsletter that covers planting reports, monthly and annual crop production, grain stocks, cattle, hogs, milk production, farm income and expenses, current and outlook information, economic trends, etc. This is also available on the SDFO website under **South Dakota Publications**.

#### **Crop Progress & Condition:**

Issued each Monday during the growing season, this report follows the condition and progress of selected crops, and provides weekly temperature and precipitation data. This is also available on the SDFO website under **South Dakota Publications**.

#### **South Dakota Agricultural Statistics Bulletin:**

Our annual bulletin contains State and County crop and livestock estimates, farm income data, land values, number of farms, prices, etc. This publication is updated and available each summer. This is also available on the SDFO website under **South Dakota Publications, Annual Statistical Bulletin**.
