SOUTH DAKOTA CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

SIOUX FALLS, S.D. August 19, 2024 - For the week ending August 18, 2024, there were 5.8 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 7% very short, 25% short, 63% adequate, and 5% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 5% very short, 20% short, 70% adequate, and 5% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Corn condition rated 2% very poor, 5% poor, 23% fair, 58% good, and 12% excellent. Corn silking was 98%, near 96% for both last year and the five-year average. Dough was 68%, near 72% last year and 66% average. Dented was 9%, behind 17% last year, and near 13% average.

Soybean condition rated 2% very poor, 5% poor, 25% fair, 58% good, and 10% excellent. Soybeans blooming was 96%, near 97% last year and 95% average. Setting pods was 76%, near 80% last year and 79% average.

Spring wheat harvested was 70%, near 69% both last year and average.

Oats harvested was 91%, ahead of 85% last year and 83% average.

Sorghum condition rated 0% very poor, 8% poor, 23% fair, 67% good, and 2% excellent. Sorghum headed was 90%, behind 98% last year, but near 86% average. Coloring was 17%, well behind 51% last year, and behind 23% average.

Sunflower condition rated 0% very poor, 6% poor, 25% fair, 64% good, and 5% excellent. Sunflowers blooming was 83%, near 80% last year.

Pasture and Range Report: Pasture and range conditions rated 4% very poor, 18% poor, 33% fair, 36% good, and 9% excellent.
