## SOUTH DAKOTA CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

**SIOUX FALLS, S.D. January 6, 2025** - For the week ending January 5, 2025, topsoil moisture supplies rated 34% very short, 45% short, 21% adequate, and 0% surplus, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 33% very short, 46% short, 21% adequate, and 0% surplus.

**Field Crops Report:** Winter wheat condition rated 12% very poor, 18% poor, 48% fair, 22% good, and 0% excellent.

The next report will be issued February 3, 2025.
