## SOUTH DAKOTA CROP PRODUCTION REPORT

**SIOUX FALLS, S.D. June 9, 2023** - Based on June 1 conditions, South Dakota's 2023 **winter wheat** crop is forecast at 34.5 million bushels, down 9% from last year's crop, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Average yield is forecast at 46 bushels per acre, down 6 bushels from last year.

Acreage to be harvested for grain is estimated at 750,000 acres, up 20,000 acres from last year. This would be 81% of the planted acres, compared with last year's 88% harvested.
