SOUTH DAKOTA JUNE 1, 2023 GRAIN STOCKS

SIoux FALLS, S.D. June 30, 2023 - South Dakota **corn** stocks in all positions on June 1, 2023 totaled 235 million bushels, up 9% from 2022, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Of the total, 150 million bushels are stored on farms, up 15% from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 84.8 million bushels, are down 1% from last year.

Soybeans stored in all positions totaled 42.2 million bushels, down 18% from last year. On-farm stocks of 16.5 million bushels are down 15% from a year ago, and off-farm stocks, at 25.7 million bushels, are down 19% from 2022.

All wheat stored in all positions totaled 21.3 million bushels, down 12% from a year ago. On-farm stocks of 8.40 million bushels are up 24% from 2022, but off-farm stocks of 12.9 million bushels are down 26% from last year.

Sorghum off-farm stocks totaled 1.05 million bushels, down 41% from June 2022.

Oats stored in all positions totaled 4.15 million bushels, up 3.03 million bushels from last year. On-farm stocks of 2.50 million bushels are up 1.63 million bushels from 2022. Off-farm stocks of 1.65 million bushels are up 1.4 million bushels from last year.

Barley on-farm stocks totaled 130,000 bushels, up 44% from June 2022.
