## SOUTH DAKOTA COMPUTER AND INTERNET USE ON FARMS

**SIOUX FALLS, S.D. August 16, 2019 -** According to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, 79 percent of South Dakota farms had access to computers in 2019. This compares to the national average of 73 percent. Eighty-two percent of farms in South Dakota had internet access, up 3 percentage points from the last time this data was collected in 2017.
