2023 Poultry Production and Value

SIOUX FALLS, S.D. April 23, 2024 - The value of **egg production** in South Dakota during 2023 was \$59.6 million, down from \$96.4 million in 2022, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service.

Egg production in 2023 was estimated at 449 million eggs, down from 593 million eggs the previous year. Average number of layers for 2023 was 1.48 million, down from 1.91 million layers in 2022.

South Dakota producers raised 3.30 million **turkeys** in 2023, up from 2.50 million birds in 2022. The value of this production was \$134 million in 2023, up from \$120 million in 2022. Pounds produced in 2023 totaled 142 million, up from 112 million pounds produced in 2022.
