Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.67 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 22, down slightly from the week prior but 1 percent above the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 22, was 4.81 million, down 1 percent from the previous week but up 38 percent from the previous year. **Texas** hatcheries set 18.1 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 22, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 22, was 5.5 million, up 4 percent from the previous week but down 63 percent from the previous year.
