Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.49 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 19, down 2 percent from the week prior and down 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 19, was 4.70 million, up slightly from the previous week and up 35 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 19.1 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 19, down slightly from the week prior, but up 6 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 19, was 5.4 million, up 1 percent from the previous week, but down 63 percent from the previous year.
