Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.60 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 7, down slightly from the week prior and 2 percent below the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 7, was 5.02 million, down 8 percent from the previous week but up 79 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.9 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 7, down 2 percent from the week prior but up 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 7, was 14.8 million, up 2 percent from the previous week and year.
