Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.79 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 2, down slightly from the week prior but 1 percent above the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of July 2, was 4.33 million, down 1 percent from the previous week but up 21 percent from the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 18.5 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 2, down 1 percent from the week prior but up 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of July 2, was 14.9 million, up 2 percent from the previous week and up 3 percent from the previous year.
