Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.34 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 25, down 1 percent from the week prior and down 5 percent the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 25, was 3.23 million, down 8 percent from the previous week and down 31 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.1 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 25, down 2 percent from the week prior and down 6 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 25, was 14.4 million, up 3 percent from the previous week but down 3 percent from the previous year.
