Oklahoma hatcheries set 5.97 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 8, up 3 percent from the week prior but down 23 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 8, was 3.55 million, down 10 percent from the previous week and down 35 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 19.5 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 8, down slightly from the week prior but up 4 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 8, was 15.2 million, down 1 percent from the previous week but up 2 percent from the previous year.
