Oklahoma hatcheries set 5.58 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 22, down 1 percent from the week prior and down 22 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 22, was 4.91 million, up 65 percent from the previous week but down 12 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 19.0 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 22, down 1 percent from the week prior but up 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 22, was 15.2 million, down 1 percent from the previous week but up 4 percent from the previous year.
