Oklahoma hatcheries set 5.87 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 27, down 3 percent from the week prior and down 23 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of July 27, was 4.86 million, up 16 percent from the previous week and up 44 percent from the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 19.6 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 27, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 9 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of July 27, was 15.3 million, up slightly from the previous week and up 3 percent from the previous year.
