**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 6.31 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 10, down slightly from the week prior and down 13 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 10, was 4.17 million, up 12 percent from the previous week and up 7 percent from the previous year. **Texas** hatcheries set 19.7 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 10, down slightly from the week prior but up 9 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 10, was 15.5 million, up 4 percent from the previous week and up 4 percent from the previous year.
