Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.11 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 5, down 1 percent from the week prior but up 4 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 5, was 4.24 million, down 10 percent from the previous week but up 28 percent from the previous year. **Texas** hatcheries set 19.1 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 5, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 13 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 5, was 13.9 million, down 6 percent from the previous week and down 3 percent from the previous year.
