**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 6.17 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 24, down 1 percent from the week prior and down 14 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 24, was 4.56 million, down 16 percent from the previous week and down 24 percent from the previous year. **Texas** hatcheries set 19.4 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 24, down 3 percent from the week prior but up 5 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 24, was 15.6 million, up slightly from the previous week and up 4 percent from the previous year.
