Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.17 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 21, up 6 percent from the week prior but down 7 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of September 21, was 3.76 million, up 1 percent from the previous week but down 2 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.5 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 21, up 5 percent from the week prior and up 4 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of September 21, was 15.3 million, down 1 percent from the previous week but up 9 percent from the previous year.
