This report contains the results from the June 2024 Hog and Pig Survey. Data provided by Oklahoma and Texas producers are the foundation of the estimates made for the Southern Plains region. We would like to thank all producers who responded to the survey. Results from the next quarterly survey will be made available September 26, 2024.

### Oklahoma Highlights

The June 1, 2024 Oklahoma hog and pig inventory, at 2.08 million head, was 5 percent lower than June 2023. The number of **breeding hogs** totaled 480 thousand head, up 10 thousand from last year. The June 1 **market hog** inventory was down 6 percent from a year ago at 1.60 million head, 77 percent of the total hog and pig inventory.

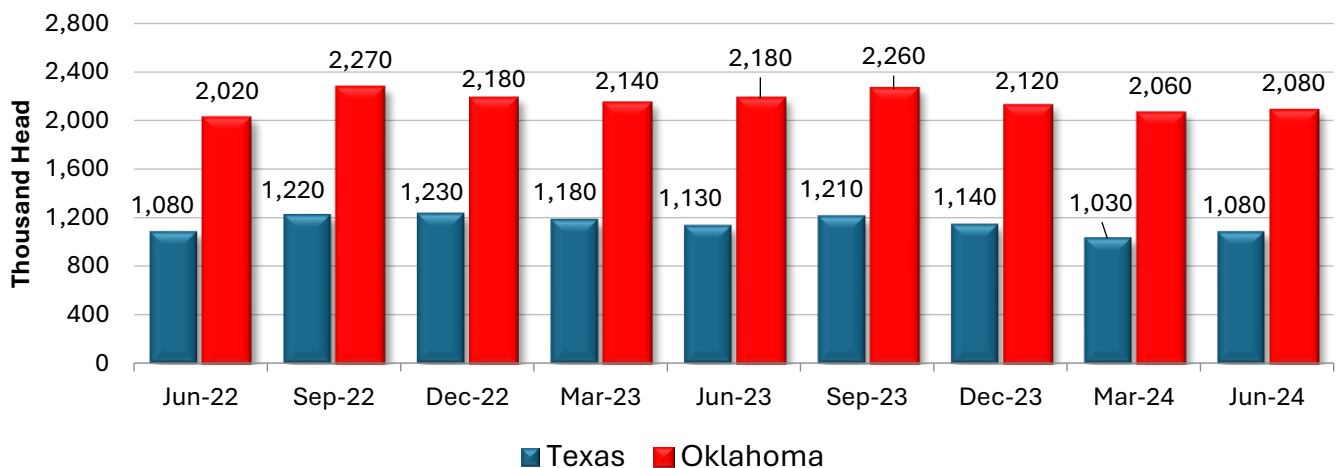
The March 2024-May 2024 Oklahoma **pig crop** totaled 2.11 million head, 4 percent below last year. Pigs per litter averaged 11.1, up 4 percent from the previous year. Sows farrowed during March 2024 through May 2024 totaled 190 thousand head, down 7 percent from last year.

### Texas Highlights

The June 1, 2024 Texas hog and pig inventory, at 1.08 million head, was 4 percent lower than June 2023. The number of **breeding hogs** totaled 130 thousand head, down 50 thousand from last year. The June 1 **market hog** inventory was unchanged from a year ago at 950 thousand head, 88 percent of the total hog and pig inventory.

The March 2024-May 2024 Texas **pig crop** totaled 710 thousand head, 14 percent below last year. Pigs per litter averaged 11.1, down 1 percent from the previous year. Sows farrowed during March 2024 through May 2024 totaled 64.0 thousand head, down 14 percent from last year.

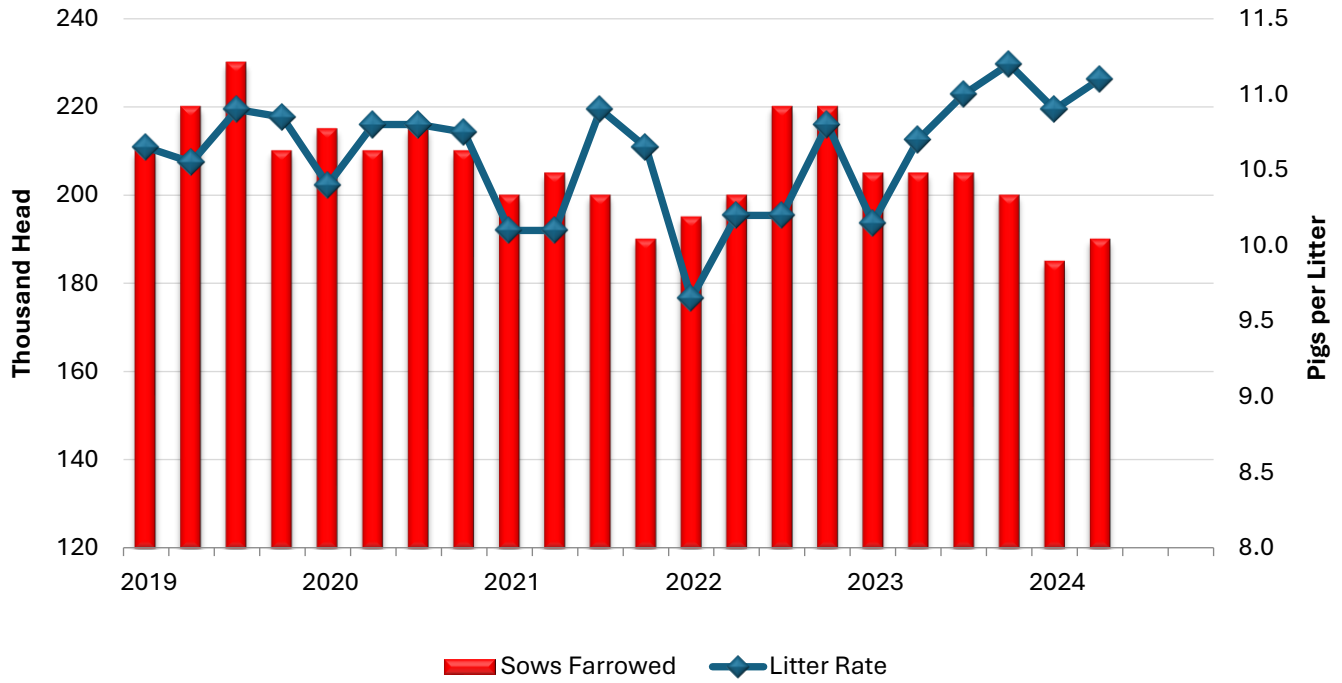

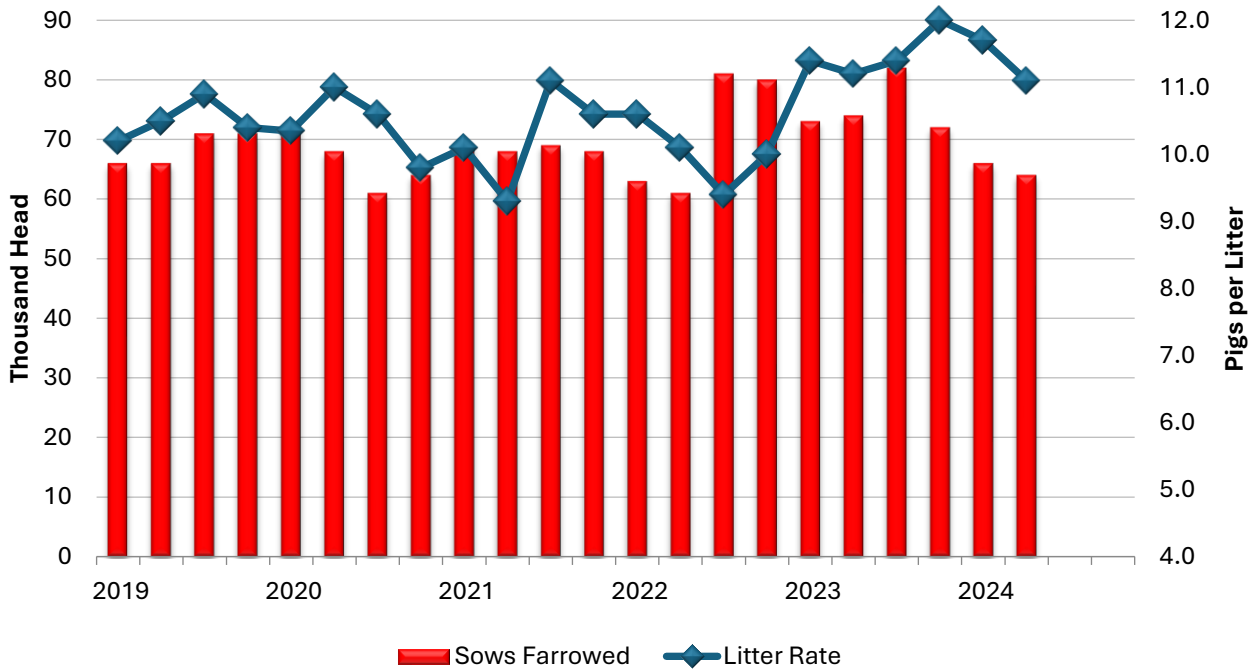

## **U.S. Highlights**

The U.S. inventory of all hogs and pigs on June 1, 2024, is estimated at 74.5 million head, up 1 percent from a year ago and up slightly from March 1, 2024. The **breeding hog inventory**, at 6.01 million head, was down 3 percent from last year and down slightly from the previous quarter. **Market hog** inventory, at 68.5 million head, was up 2 percent from last year and up slightly from last quarter.

The U.S. **pig crop** for March 2024-May 2024, at 34.0 million, was up 2 percent from 2023. U.S. producers intend to have 2.96 million sows farrow during the June 2024-August 2024 quarter, down 3 percent from the actual farrowings during the same period last year. Intended farrowings for September 2024-November 2024, at 2.94 million sows, are down 1 percent from the same quarter the year prior.
