Oklahoma hatcheries set 5.83 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 1, down 3 percent from the week prior but up 7 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 1, was 3.91 million, up 12 percent from the previous week and up 2 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.7 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 1, down 6 percent from the week prior and down 5 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 1, was 15.1 million, down 3 percent from the previous week but up 4 percent from the previous year.
