Oklahoma hatcheries set 5.90 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 8, up 4 percent from the week prior and up 8 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 8, was 3.68 million, down 6 percent from the previous week and down 5 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 19.4 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 8, up 3 percent from the week prior and up 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 8, was 14.9 million, down 1 percent from the previous week but up 4 percent from the previous year.
