JULY – SEPTEMBER 2024 QUARTERLY MILK PRODUCTION MOUNTAIN REGION HIGHLIGHTS

Arizona dairy herds produced 1.07 billion pounds of milk during the July – September quarter, down 4.2 percent from the previous year.

Colorado dairy herds produced 1.30 billion pounds of milk during the July – September quarter, up 0.1 percent from the previous year.

Montana dairy herds produced 49.0 million pounds of milk during the July – September quarter, down 5.8 percent from the previous year.

New Mexico dairy herds produced 1.44 billion pounds of milk during the July – September quarter, down 9.8 percent from the previous year.

Utah dairy herds produced 532.0 million pounds of milk during the July – September quarter, up 0.8 percent from the previous year.

Wyoming dairy herds produced 63.9 million pounds of milk during the July – September quarter, up 2.2 percent from the previous year.

UNITED STATES HIGHLIGHTS

Milk production in the United States during the July – September quarter totaled 56.0 billion pounds, up slightly from the July - September quarter last year.
