
<u>Agricultural News:</u> Days suitable for fieldwork were 5.0. Weather conditions were warm with scattered precipitation. Average high temperatures were mostly in the upper 70s. There are abnormally dry to extreme drought conditions in the State. Farming activities for the week included making hay, planting small grain crops, and harvesting apples, corn, cotton, peanuts, and soybeans. Forage supplies remain tight.






## APPLES HARVESTED for week ending 9/22/24
