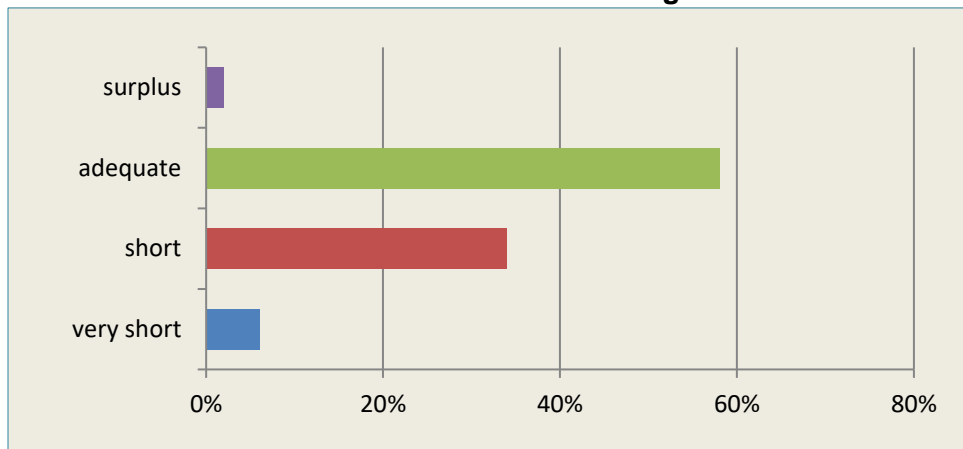
Agricultural News: This is the last weekly Virginia Crop Weather Bulletin of the year. Monthly reports will be published during the winter months. We would like to thank our federal, state and county cooperative partners for their valuable help in providing the information that makes this publication possible. Days suitable for fieldwork were 5.9. Weather conditions were cool with some light rain. Average high temperatures were mostly in the lower 60s. There are abnormally dry to severe drought conditions in the State. Farming activities for the week included harvesting cotton and soybeans.

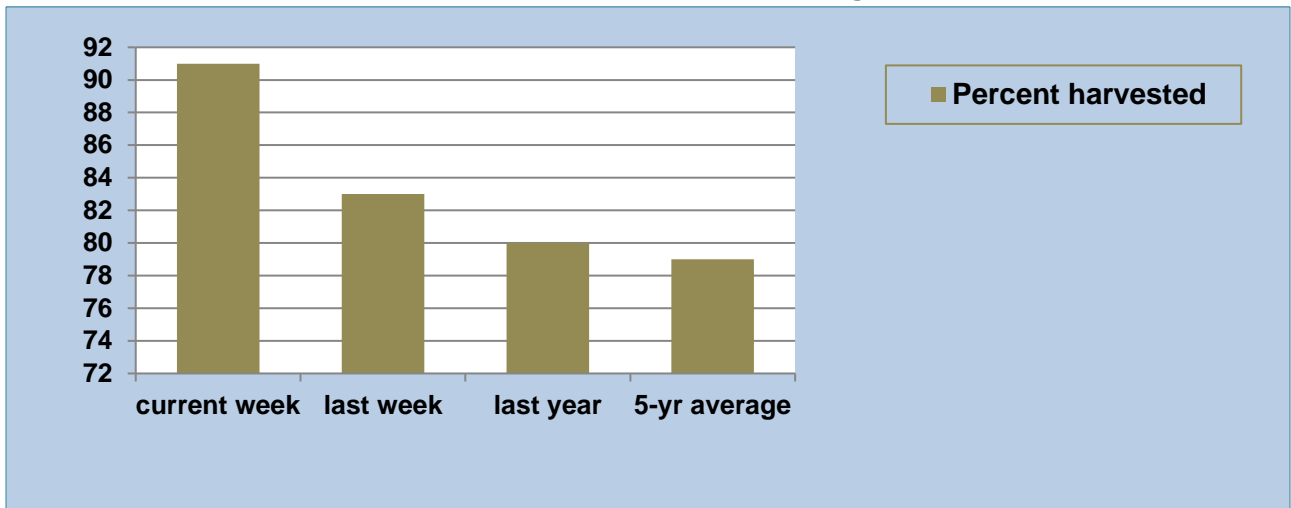

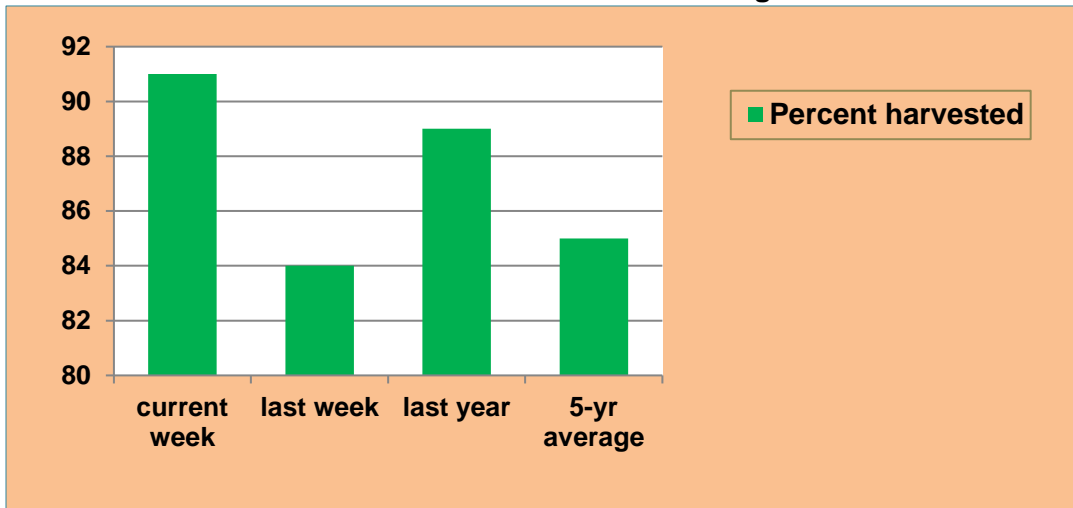

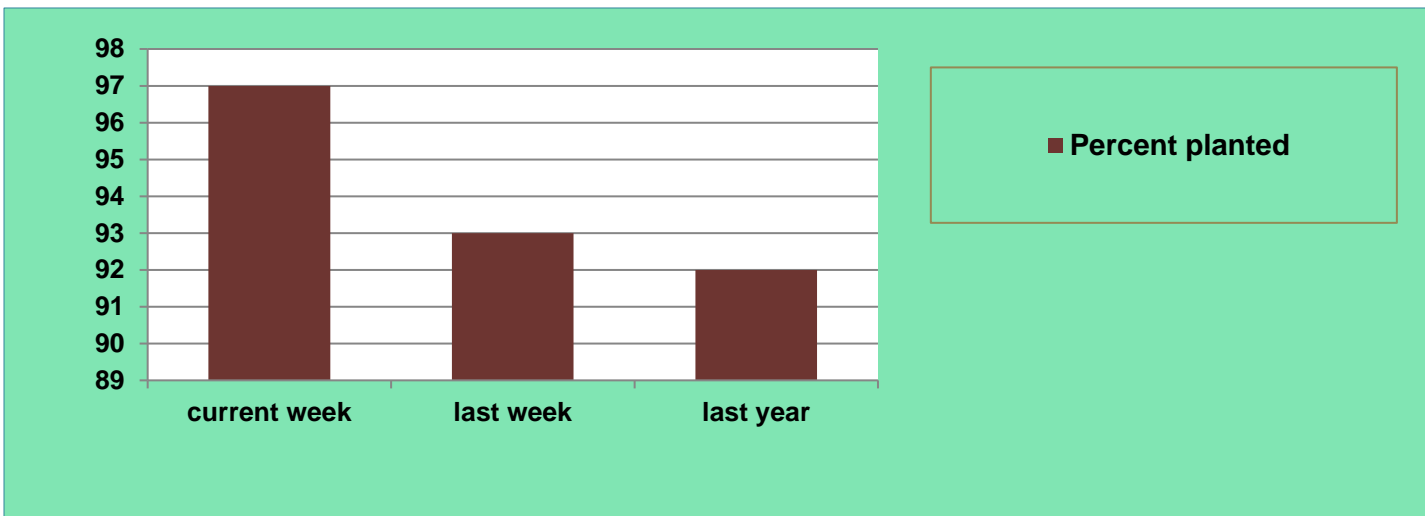
COTTON HARVESTED for week ending 11/24/24
