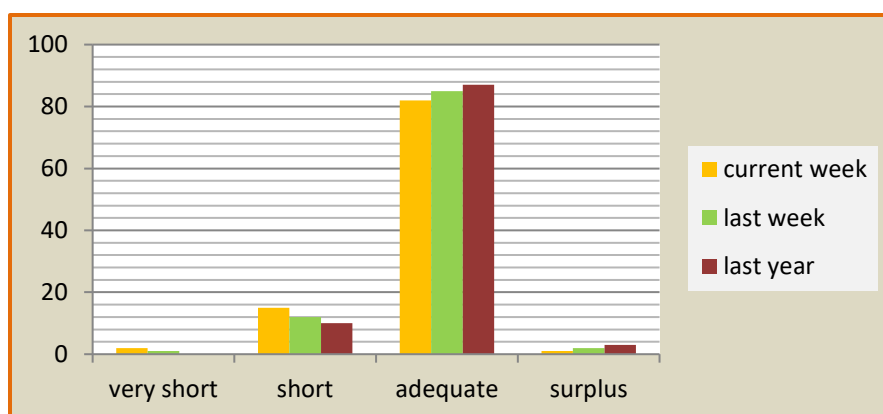
Agricultural News: Days suitable for fieldwork were 5.7. Farming activities this week included making hay and harvesting apples and corn.
