The Wisconsin all milk price for March 2024 was \$19.10 per hundredweight (cwt) according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service - Agricultural Prices report. This was 10 cents above last month's price but \$1.60 below last March's price. The U.S. all milk price for March was \$20.70 per cwt, \$1.60 higher than Wisconsin's price and 10 cents higher than last month's U.S. price.
