The average price received by farmers for **corn** during May 2024 in Wisconsin was \$4.25 per bushel according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service – *Agricultural Prices* report. This was 11 cents above the April price but \$1.99 below May 2023.

The May 2024 average price received by farmers for **soybeans**, at \$11.70 per bushel, was 20 cents above the April price but \$2.70 below the May 2023 price.

The May average **oat** price per bushel, at \$4.22, was 76 cents above April and 18 cents above May 2023.

All hay prices in Wisconsin averaged \$177.00 per ton in May. This was \$8.00 below the April price but \$17.00 above the May 2023 price. The May 2024 **alfalfa hay** price, at \$185.00, was \$9.00 below the previous month but \$15.00 above May 2023. The average price received for **other hay** during May was \$150.00 per ton. This was \$6.00 below the April price but \$37.00 above May last year.

The average price for **milk** was \$21.30 per cwt, \$2.70 above the April price and \$3.20 above May 2023.

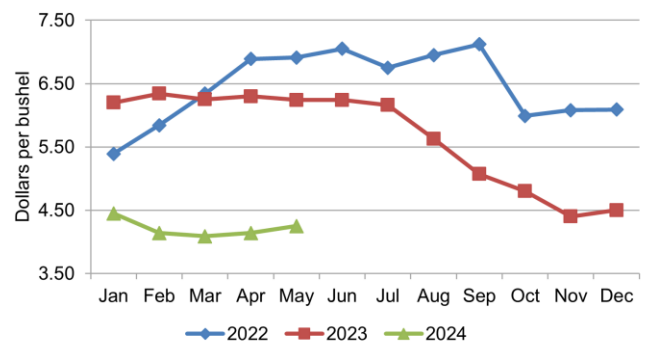
