CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION WEEK ENDING MAY 24, 2015

AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY: Most of Wyoming had below normal temperatures and wet conditions for the week. Our Converse County reporter indicated excellent spring moisture but corral conditions are deplorable. Lincoln County reports receiving rain throughout the week and the ground is soggy wet. The range land vegetation looks great with a lot of grasses coming. Wyoming's cattle and calf death loss was rated as 50 percent average and 50 percent light. Sheep and lamb death loss was rated as 2 percent heavy, 55 percent average and 43 percent light. Stock water supplies were rated 3 percent short, 93 percent adequate, and 4 percent surplus.
