

## **CROP PRODUCTION - NOVEMBER 1, 2023**

## WYOMING HIGHLIGHTS

Based on November 1 conditions, **sugarbeet** production in Wyoming is forecast at 844,000 tons, unchanged from the October 1 forecast but up 4 percent from the 812,000 tons produced in 2022. Harvested area, forecast at 28,500 acres, is up 600 acres from last year. Yields are expected to average 29.6 tons per acre, unchanged from the October 1 forecast but up from 29.1 tons a year ago. As of October 29, producers had harvested 81 percent of the sugarbeet crop, compared with 96 percent last year and the 5-year average of 87 percent.

## **UNITED STATES HIGHLIGHTS**

Production of **sugarbeets** for the 2023 crop year is forecast at 35.5 million tons, up 2 percent from last month and up 9 percent from last year. Producers expect to harvest 1.12 million acres, unchanged from last month but down 2 percent from last year. Yield is forecast at 31.7 tons per acre, up 0.6 ton from last month and up 3.1 tons from last year.
