CROP PRODUCTION – NOVEMBER 1, 2024

WYOMING HIGHLIGHTS

Based on November 1 conditions, **sugarbeet** production in Wyoming is forecast at 1.04 million tons, up 2 percent from the October 1 forecast and up 22 percent from the 847,000 tons produced in 2023, according to the November 1 Agricultural Yield Survey conducted by the Mountain Regional Field Office of the National Agricultural Statistics Service, USDA. Harvested area, forecast at 31,000 acres, is unchanged from last month but up 2,200 acres from last year. Yields are expected to average 33.4 tons per acre, up 0.8 ton from the October 1 forecast and up from 32.6 tons a year ago. As of November 3, producers had harvested 86 percent of the crop, compared with 88 percent last year.

UNITED STATES HIGHLIGHTS

Production of **sugarbeets** for the 2024 crop year is forecast at 35.2 million tons, down 1 percent from last month and down slightly from last year. Producers expect to harvest 1.08 million acres, unchanged from last month but down 5 percent from last year. Yield is forecast at 32.7 tons per acre, down 0.4 ton from last month but up 1.5 tons from last year.
