



Dear Wyoming Agriculturalist,

Wyoming cattle producers lost an estimated 41,000 head of cattle and calves to many causes in 2012, including weather, calving, respiratory diseases and predators. The data for these estimates is collected in conjunction with our annual January Cattle Survey. Total losses were down 2,000 head from 2011, mainly due to a milder winter. Death loss as a percentage of Wyoming's total cattle and calves inventory was 3 percent, unchanged from 2011. Predators accounted for 11 percent of combined cattle and calf loss, while respiratory problem was the biggest contributor to loss at 26 percent. The total value of all losses to all causes was estimated at \$30.1 million.
