**MORAVIAN 69 REIGNING LEADER FOR FIFTH YEAR IN A ROW**

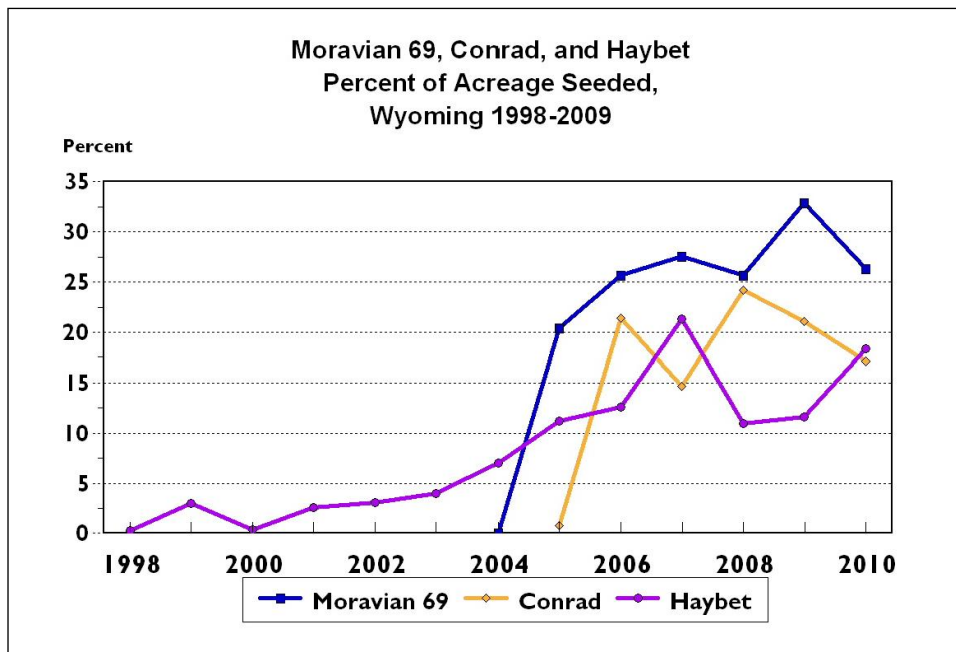
**Moravian 69** remained in the leading position as the most popular barley variety planted in Wyoming since 2006. **Moravian 69** was seeded on an estimated 18,400 acres. This variety accounted for 38 percent of malting variety seeding and 26 percent of Wyoming's total barley acreage. **Haybet** was the leading feed barley variety in Wyoming for the fifth year in a row. **Haybet** was seeded on an estimated 12,900 acres. This variety accounted for 61 percent of the feed variety and 18 percent of Wyoming's total barley acreage. **Conrad** was the second most popular malting variety for the fifth year in a row with 12,000 acres seeded, accounting for 25 percent of the malting barley and 17 percent of the State's total barley acres. **Merit** was the third most popular malting variety for the fifth year in a row with 7,300 acres seeded, accounting for 15 percent of the malting barley and 10 percent of the State's total barley acres. **Baronesse** was the second leading feed barley variety in Wyoming during 2010. **Baronesse** was seeded on an estimated 3,400 acres. This variety accounted for 16 percent of the feed variety and 5 percent of Wyoming's total barley acreage.

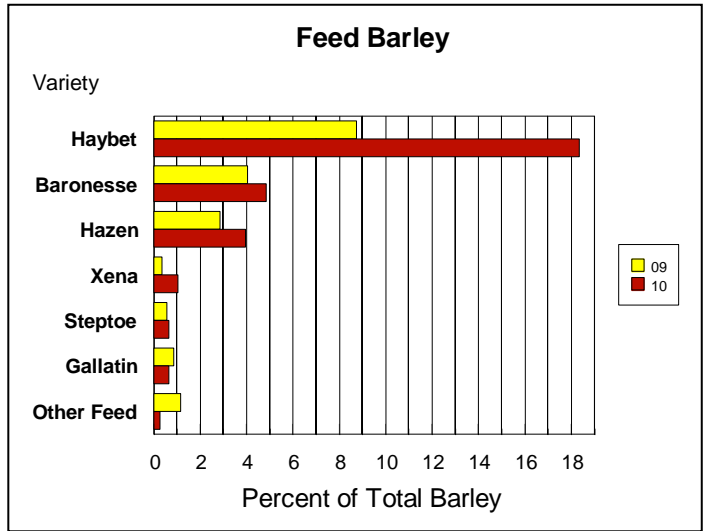
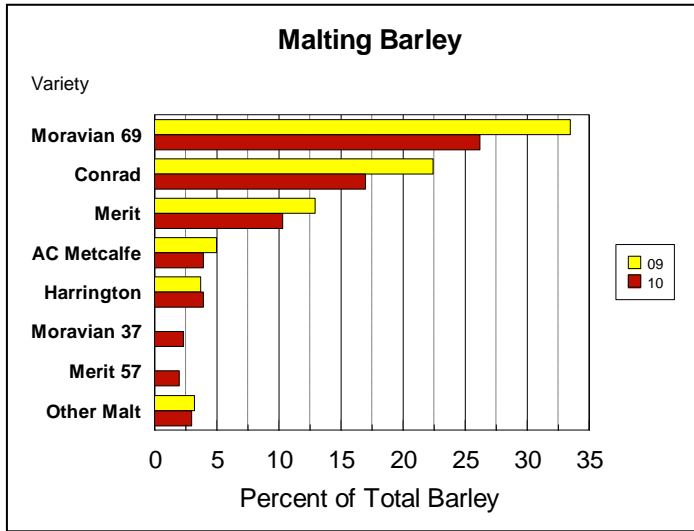
Wyoming barley producers planted an estimated 70,000 acres to all barley varieties in 2010, down 10,000 acres from 2009. The Northwest District had 62 percent of the barley acreage in 2010, compared with 66 percent last year.

Malting varieties accounted for 48,800 acres or 70 percent of the total.

Acreage planted to feed barley totaled 21,200 acres, 30 percent of Wyoming's total barley acreage.

The Barley Variety Survey was conducted throughout the month of June by the Wyoming Field Office of USDA NASS via phone and mail. The American Malting Barley Association, Inc. provided the funding for this survey. We thank the Wyoming producers who voluntarily provided information that led to these estimates.
